**The Modern School, ECNCR** was established in the year 2014, in the Rajiv Gandhi Education City, NCR Delhi. It is a branch of Modern School, Barakhamba Road, Delhi. Since its establishment in 2014, the school has been guided by its core values of Integrity, Pursuit of Excellence, Sensitivity and Pride in One's Own Heritage. It inherited a great history immersed in tradition.

The Founder of Modern School was Lala Raghbir Singh. His vision was to establish a school which would combine the traditions of Indian Education with modern education techniques and foster an all round growth of the child.

### **MISSION: 'Self realization cannot be attained by the weak willed'**

Spread over lush green, pollution free area of 11 acres it is a composite day school which includes Pre-Primary, Primary, Middle and Secondary wings. With a total capacity to educate approximately 2500 students, the school is affiliated with the Central Board of Secondary Education, the foremost examining body of the country. The school is equipped with an environment friendly modern architecture, Solar Power backup upto 100KW, with a state of the art academic and sports infrastructure. It houses interactive whiteboards and projection screens in every class room in order to integrate information communication technology with classroom learning. It houses facilities like library, art, music and dance room, AV room, computer, mathematics, social science and science laboratories. The sports field provides football, basketball, lawn tennis, volley ball courts as well as a state of art skating rink. Co-curricular activities form an integral part of the students over all development. Excellence in academics, sports, visual and performing arts and newly emerging fields of study are given equal opportunities to shine.

## **ASSESSMENT CRITERIA AND REPORTING:**

Students are evaluated following the systematic format of Formative and Summative assessments. Student learning is measured on an ongoing basis through regular cycle tests, term examinations and internal assessments. Formal examinations are introduced in Grade IV.

## **OPPORTUNITIES:**

Students participate in a myriad of activities and are exposed to multiple experiential learning programmes, such as Leadership and Mentoring, Disaster Management, Life Skills, After School Activities and competitive standardised examinations such as OLYMPIAD exams. The student body is empowered and manages multiple societies and an editorial board under the supervision of teacher coordinators. The students participate in inter-school, intra-school and national athletic meets, leagues and games. To inculcate the value of social responsibility in our students, the school has a strong environment and community service programme. The school is a part of the Rotary Interact Club and undertakes its social and community development activities under their guidance.

## **EXAMINATION AND PROMOTION:**

**The Modern School** follows the following examination and promotion policy:-

1. **Primary Classes (P1- P3)** - The session is divided into two terms. Students are marked in each term for scholastic and co scholastic areas on a 5 point and 3 point grading scale. Scholastic areas comprises of written assessments, oral skills, subject enrichment activities and notebook upkeep and submission
2. **Classes P4- P5** - The session is divided into two terms. Students are marked in each term for scholastic and co scholastic areas on a 5 point and 3 point grading scale. Scholastic areas include Periodic Assessment of 40 marks converted to 10 and written assessments, oral skills, subject enrichment activities and notebook upkeep and submission. Half Yearly/ Final Examination of 80 marks each is conducted.
3. **Classes S1-S3** - The session is divided into two terms. Students are marked in each term for scholastic and co scholastic areas on a 5 point and 3 point grading scale. Scholastic areas include Periodic Assessment of 40 marks converted to 10 and written assessments, oral skills, subject enrichment activities and notebook upkeep and submission. Half Yearly/ Final Examination of 80 marks each is conducted.
4. **Classes S4-S5** – The assessment shall be as per the CBSE pattern. Three periodic assessments and one Final Exam of 80 marks each shall be conducted.
