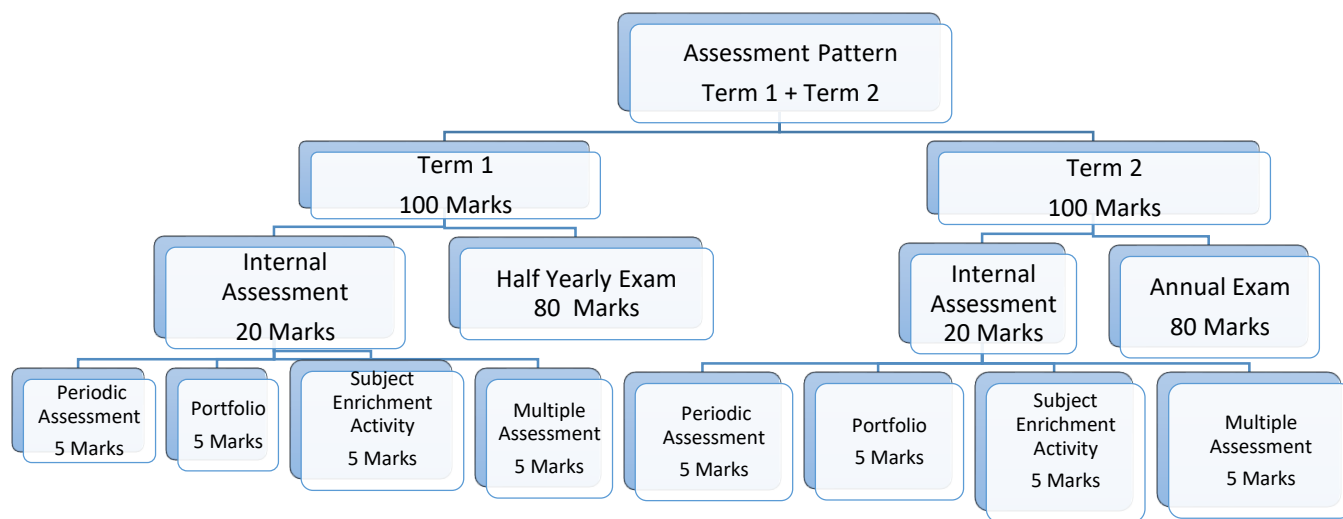

Scholastic Areas (to be graded on 8-point scale A1-E)

➤ **Internal Assessment (20 Marks) comprises of:**

- (i) Periodic Assessment (05 marks): Periodic Assessment comprising of 40 marks will be converted into 5 marks.
- (ii) Multiple Assessment (05 Marks): Projects, Oral test, Assignments or Written Work done in the class, Group Work, Class Discussion, Field-Work, Concept Maps, Graphic Organizers, Visual Representations etc.
- (iii) Portfolio & Notebook upkeep and submission (05 Marks): Art Integrated Project, A collection of Students' Learning Achievements, Assignment Completion and Neatness, Peer Assessment and Self –Assessment, Achievements of Student in the Subject, Classwork.

(iv) Subject Enrichment Activities (05 Marks):

- Languages: ASL (Assessment of Speaking and Listening Skills)
 - Mathematics: Lab Activities
 - Science: Practical work and activities
 - Social Science: Map and project work
- **HALF YEARLY/ANNUAL EXAM (80 Marks)** comprises of Written Assessment of 80 marks each.
- Half Yearly: Term 1 Syllabus will be assessed
 - Annual Exam: Cumulative Syllabus will be assessed

Co-Scholastic Areas (to be graded on 5-point scale A-E)

- Art Education (Visual and Performing Art): As opted
- Health and Physical Education: Health and FITNESS, SEWA/COMMUNITY SERVICE
- Work Experience: Club as opted
- Discipline - Assessment will be based on the factors like attendance, sincerity, behaviour, values, tidiness, respectfulness etc.

NOTE: Time to time amendments done as per CBSE guidelines

- **75% of the total attendance** is mandatory to sit for Annual Exam

PROMOTION POLICY - S4

1. A student who is unable to take any **Periodic Assessment(s)** on the scheduled date

- No Retest will be conducted.
- In case of Medical emergency, class teacher must be notified immediately. Medical Certificate must be provided within two days. Student will be awarded with average marks in the given subject in the final report card.
- Student who misses an exam for not the above-mentioned reasons will be considered as absent and no marks will be awarded.

2. In Annual Examination

- If any student misses **Annual Exam** in any subject due to medical emergency with due permission of authorities, retest will be conducted in the subject.
- If any student scores (below 33%) in two subjects or less, student will appear for retest for the same subject.
- If any student is failing in three main subjects, then student will be detained and will not be promoted to the next class.
- If any student is unable to clear the Retest, student will be considered as fail and will not be promoted to the next class.
