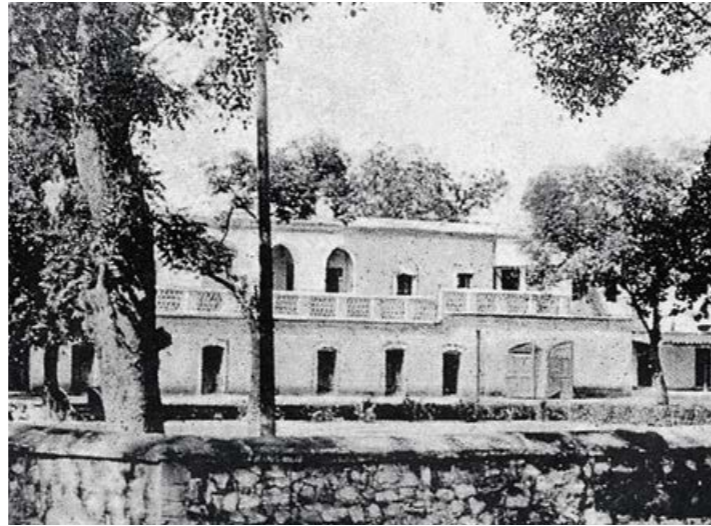

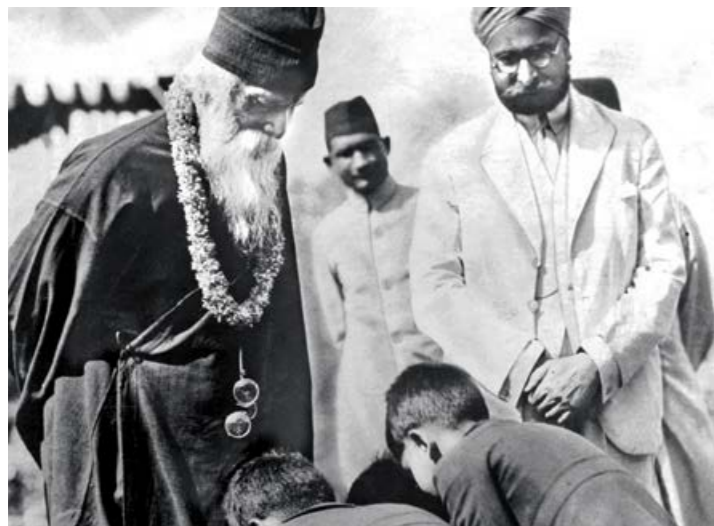

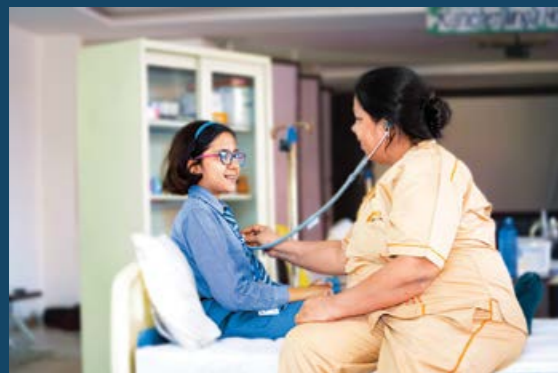

Our Security

Parents' trust is our responsibility and we go to every length to ensure our children's safety, through Police verified staff, security guards, CCTV cameras, electric fencing and all other necessary measures for safety.

Our vigilant team ensures a safe & secure environment for our students in the school.



The boarding house building and smart automated environment has been designed in such a way that the children can enjoy safe and secured life in the campus. The boarding house premises have central locking system which is under continuous computerised monitoring supervision. Besides all these facilities/systems installed for taking care of the security of the children, they will be safe under the supervision of the vigil eyes of the Head residences and House Parents with support of security guards. Separate entry and accommodation is provided for boys and girls without any chances of infiltration from either of the campuses. Girls' campus is under the supervision of female staff and lady security guard.



Transport Facilities

To ensure a safe & enjoyable travel, the school has its own air conditioned buses managed by trained drivers and personnel sensitised to the needs of children. Our buses are equipped with facility of CCTV, GPS tracking technology & medical care. We have trained female security staff on board with complete background check for taking care of our students.

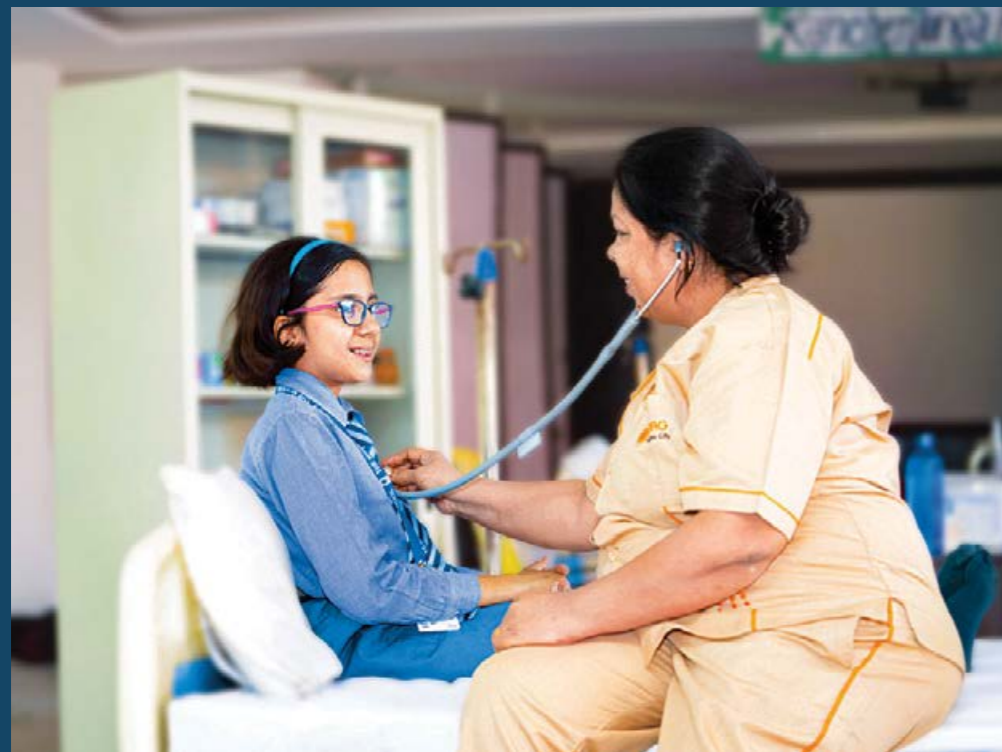
Boarding House Facility

While providing boarding house facility, we ensure that a student never feels emotionally & physically insecure. Our boarding houses is a 'home away from home' for its resident scholars. Our motto is that after school hours, all facilities must be available to our resident scholars, which a scholar enjoys after reaching home, be it safe environment, emotional support, latest amenities, health facilities, educational guidance or fresh & healthy food. This nurturing environment ensures that our boarders grow up to be independent, confident & self-disciplined individuals.



Home Away From Home

Our boarding house is established with State of the Art infrastructure. It can accommodate upto 200 students. Its residential scheme is divided into three categories i.e. Two Beds, Four Beds and Eight Beds dormitory, which shall be allocated to the students on the basis of class in which the students are studying. The boarding house is equipped with all facilities and amenities to take care of the conveniences of the resident scholars on one hand and with latest technologies for energy saving, control, supervision and security measures on the other hand.



Residential Programme

The boarding facilities are designed for comfortable stay of its resident scholars. During week days, the resident scholars shall be busy with the school activities and in the weekends, they will enjoy extracurricular activities and a relaxed environment to take care of their childhood and teenage perspective. The head residences and house parents are always available for the timely care of the resident scholars. Resident Scholars have the option to choose between seven day or five day residential programme. Under five day residential programme, they can avail the boarding house facility from Monday to Friday. They leave for home on Friday and come back to school on Monday morning. Transport facility from focal points will be provided by the school.



Infrastructure

The boarding house is a part of the school campus which is spread over 11.25 acres. Its building is constructed with State of the Art Architecture with all comforts & services which are required for the students to take care of their educational as well as personal needs as a human being.

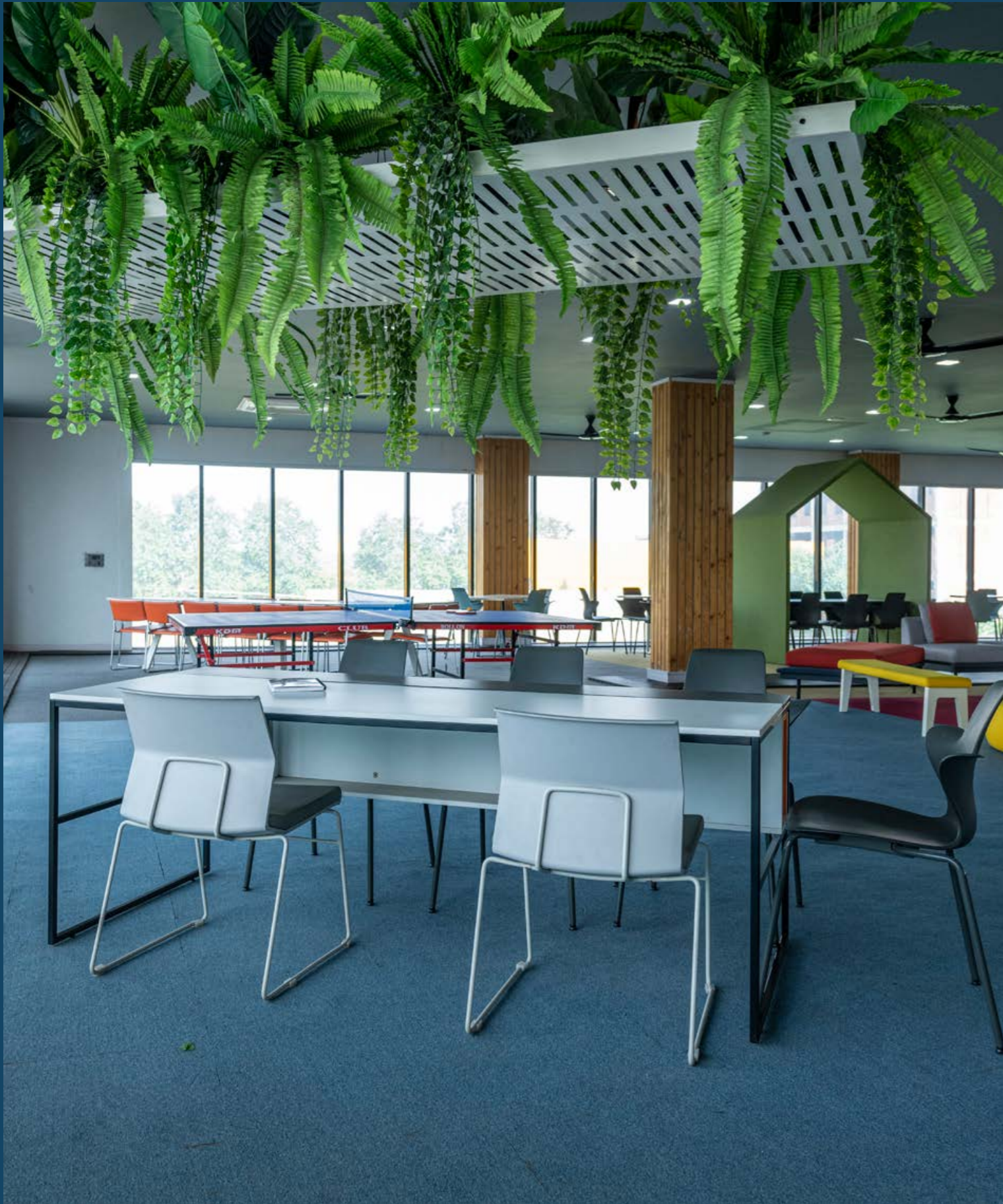

Items not Permissible

If any of the following items are found in a scholars-in-residence possession on campus the same will be confiscated. House Parents will give a receipt to the scholars-in-residence in question.

- Snacks like Cakes, Chocolates, Wafers, Chips, Coffee, Tea, Milk Powder, Sugar, Soft drinks, Noodles, Home-made items etc. (Dry Fruits, Iced Tea and Tang are allowed)
- Camera (Only scholars who are members of the Photography Club can bring a camera)
- Medicines without prescriptions.
- Head phones (Earphones are allowed).
- External speakers (any type). [Note: Electronic Music Equipment like an MP3 player may be used in the boarding rooms on Sundays, Holidays and during the daily rest hours only. It must not be taken to class at any time.]
- Toxic items, possession of smoking and drinking materials or any eatables, fireworks, darts, cutters or any other sharp objects are strictly forbidden.
- External Hard Drives.
- Wi-Fi devices and routers.
- Electric Appliances like Irons, Kettles, Food warmers etc.
- I Pod, PSPs (MP3 without screen is allowed).
- Watches exceeding Rs 5000.
- Knives and or any cutting tool/device.
- Cash / Gold / Jewellery / Ornaments. Match Box / Lighters.
- Razors / Shavers with removable blades (cartridge type blades permitted).

Note: This list will be amended/updated from time to time.

Important Notes for Parents:

- All the articles brought by the student should be marked with his/her name.
- All the clothes brought by the student, need to be labelled with the student's first name and the admission number.
- Boarders need to buy 6 sets of the School Uniform.
- The student needs to carry 20 passport size photographs of himself/herself.
- Other than a simple watch (for boys and girls), Jewellery (Ear Ring for girls only), no student is allowed to carry any other valuable material. The school holds no responsibility whatsoever for the loss of any of the above.
- Any medication carried by a student must be handed over to the House Parent directly. Medication will be administered by the School Nurse, as per prescription provided by Parents.
- Parents are required to read the above carefully as these are enforced strictly. No exceptions will be made.

Residential Policy & Guidelines

- Ragging/Bullying in any form is unacceptable and will be dealt with strongly.
- All scholars-in-residence are under the over-all charge of the Head-Residences, through their respective House Parents. The House Parents are responsible for the adherence to The Daily Routine and their all-round development, Pastoral care and progress in Academics, Sport, Co-Curricular activities, manners, etiquette and discipline.
- All activities and movements of the scholars will be with the permission and under the supervision of House Parents. No scholars-in-residence can exit the school without the written permission of the House Parent.
- No scholar is permitted to go out of the premises of the Residences/ Floor to visit any other Residence/ Floor without the prior permission of the respective House Parent.
- Visitors/Parents are normally not allowed to visit the scholars-in-residence in their Residences. In special cases e.g. illness, the permission of the respective House Parent must be taken.
- The scholars-in-residence must be properly attired. This includes a proper haircut, clipped and clean nails, hair bands (for girls), neat and clean school uniform etc.
- No scholar is permitted to buy/sell or exchange goods or lend/borrow money.
- The scholars-in-residence are expected to respect the property of the Boarding and its individual rooms. Any damage to property/vandalism to property shall be charged to the scholars individually/collectively.
- Scholars must converse in English always.
- Scholars-in-residence feeling unwell must inform their House Parent or report to the School Infirmary for investigation.
- No Scholar-in-Residence is permitted to ask another student in residence (SIR) for any undue favours.
- Scholars must switch off the Lights/Fans/ACs when the rooms are not occupied.
- Scholars need to make their beds every morning, and keep their cupboards and rooms neat and organised.
- Parents are requested to provide a basic mobile phone to their children.
- All 7 Day scholars-in-residence are allowed phone calls twice a week (Wednesday & Sunday). All 5 Day scholars-in-residence are allowed phone calls once a week (Thursday). The duration of the call will be approximately 15 minutes.
- There are times when the scholars-in-residence may be busy on the phone call day due to a rehearsal, practice or any other activity. The call can be made the following day.
- Boarders should submit their phones and any non-permissible item within 15 minutes of their arrival to their respective House Parents.
- Scholars can use MP3s (without screen) only on weekends.
- Scholars can bring Laptops to school. These devices are to be used as per schedule established by the House Master and need to be submitted to the House Parents at 10 pm. The use of such devices is governed by The School Internet Usage policy.
- Scholars-in-residence can celebrate their birthdays with a cake which will be provided by The Central Dining Hall. Orders/Deliveries of cake from outside will not be entertained. The birthday cake may be ordered through a debit voucher signed by the scholar and handed over to the House Parent concerned. Scholars can distribute chocolates/toffees etc. not exceeding Rs. 20 each, for distribution in their class. These items could also be sourced through the Tuck Shop.
- Parents/Guardians are advised to refrain from coming on weekdays except during an emergency, and that too after prior written intimation (via SMS/Email/approval of the Head-Residences).
- Parents/Guardians of 7 Day scholars-in-residence may take their ward out of campus on the second Saturday of the month, for the weekend.
- Pick-up and drop facility of boarders to the airport/railway station before and after vacations is provided by the school, on pre-determined dates. A request along with a copy of ticket must be sent to the House Parent with a copy to The School Office (Boarding@modernschoolec.com) at least 15 days in advance. Tickets may be booked in consultation with the respective House Parent and conform to the pick/drop schedule.
- The Residences are closed during Summer & Winter vacations. Kindly check the dates in the school calendar. During these holidays, all scholars will be required to be off campus.
- Possession/consumption of any type of cigarette/alcohol/narcotic substance on campus is strictly prohibited and shall be dealt with very firmly.

Residential Policy & Guidelines

- Leave must be sanctioned before it commences. All leave applications are to be addressed to the Head – Residences and routed through the concerned House Parent.
- No scholar will be allowed to leave the campus unescorted. Scholars leaving the campus with relatives/drivers/friends or any other person besides the Parent/Guardian must be of legal age and have an Authority Letter duly signed by the Parent taking responsibility.
- The scholar must collect the Gate Pass from their respective House Parent only.
- All 5 Day Scholars-in-residence must leave the campus latest by 5.30 pm on Friday. They are not allowed to stay in the Residences over the weekend.
- On return from the weekend/outing, all SIR's must report at 7.00 pm.
- Scholars are not allowed to bring non-permissible items into the school. Security personnel check the luggage of all scholars when they return, against the list of nonpermissible items. All non-permissible items are returned to the Parent/Escort there and then. If they are not available, then items will be deposited with the boarding office.
- All Passports/Credit/Debit cards, carried by Scholars-in-residence are to be handed over to the school office, on arrival. This will be handed over to the scholar when they are journeying home.
- Overseas Scholars-in-residence must take care of the FRRO document attached to their Passports and ensure that they carry the same with them when they re-enter the country.
- Medicines/Preparations from home are permitted if approved by the school doctor and accompanied by a prescription from a registered medical practitioner and the Parents' request in writing. These medicines will not be allowed in the residences and will be deposited with the boarding house Infirmary. The scholar will need to take these medicines in the presence of the school nurse on duty.
- Scholars recovering from infectious diseases will be allowed to attend school only on the approval of the school doctor. (Parents/Guardians should not drop the scholars to school without seeking the school doctors approval.)
- All instructions for the boarding house Infirmary must be communicated in writing or via email from the registered email ID and mobile phone number as provided in the scholars' records. (Any changes must therefore be updated in the school database by approaching the school office.)
- Scholars must strictly follow the clothing list provided at the time of admission. All personal clothes must be tagged by the parents to enable easy identification during laundry and otherwise.

- Scholars-in-residence will not be permitted to enter the boarding during school hours. unless the scholar-in-residence is not well and/or is on a special diet, all meals will be consumed in the central dining hall.
- If a scholar-in-residence is unwell, he/she is advised to visit the Infirmary immediately. The Infirmary will further inform the concerned House Parent.

- Asking before using other people's property- 'borrowing' without permission is theft
- Respect for property and the environment
- Treating Boarding and school property and facilities with respect
- Not participating in wilful damage, vandalism and theft. These are considered serious offences and will result in disciplinary action
- Protecting gardens and areas around the Residences
- Reporting any damage to staff

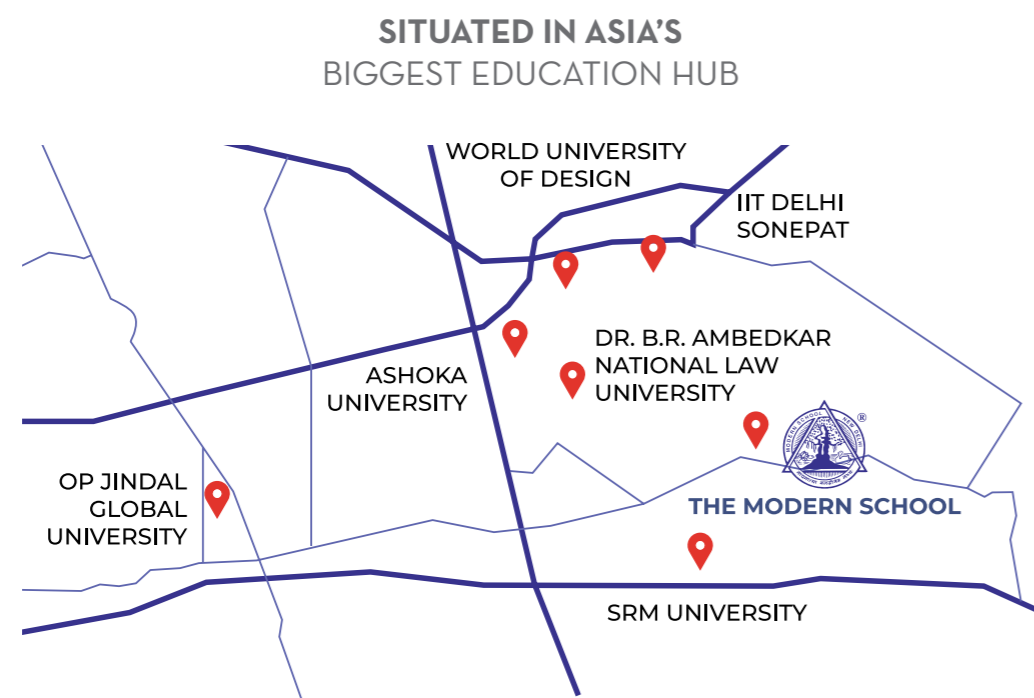
